



### Who can apply?

The Certis Belchim MSc Scholarship will be awarded to up to two students who are studying for an MSc in Integrated Pest, Weed & Disease Management, Entomology, Plant Pathology or AgroEcology, completing research that is of direct interest to Certis.

Certis Belchim provides reliable and profitable crop protection strategies through their innovative products and expertise in IPM development and implementation. A leader in this field, their core focus remains developing innovative Biorational solutions for a variety of horticultural and arable field crops.

During this project, the student will have the opportunity to work on either a:

- Literature review of allelopathic herbicidal compounds; or
- Screening of new bio-insecticide(s) on several species of aphids.

Note: Applicants must not be in receipt of any other sponsorship / scholarship which would state a conflict of interest.

#### The Scholarship

The successful Scholarship recipients will receive an award valued at up to £2,500 for one year only.

# **IMPORTANT:** To be shortlisted for interview, applicants must have a confirmed place on the course noted above at Harper Adams University at the time they submit their application.

All of the above conditions must be fully met for an application to be considered.

The scholarship will be payable in two equal parts; half to be paid in February 2024 and the balance in May 2023. Payment is conditional on the scholar remaining registered as a **full-time student** at Harper Adams. They must pass all modules of study and submit at least one letter reporting on progress to the Development Trust prior to the receipt of their second payment.

This is a competitive award which will be evaluated on merit of the submitted application, along with academic achievements to date and interview.

The Development Trust embraces diversity and promotes equality of opportunity and access to higher education. The Trust has been successful in supporting a wide range of students. It strongly encourages applications from students of all backgrounds. Where there are two applicants of equal merit, preference will be given to applicants who are from backgrounds that are underrepresented in UK higher education.

The decision of the Certis Belchim Scholarship Panel is **FINAL** and they reserve the right to withdraw the award at any time should they feel this action is required.

#### Shortlisted applicants are required to attend a panel interview on Thursday 7 December 2023

- 1. **Consent Form** this must be completed and signed to show that you have read and understood the Privacy & Data Protection Notice (you can type your name into the signature box)
- 2. In a **covering letter** of no more than two pages, addressed to Mrs D Taylor, explain why you would be interested in receiving the Certis Belchim MSc Scholarship, and:
  - Why you have selected to study your chosen course
  - How the receipt of this award would make a difference to you
  - What your long term career aspirations are
- 3. CV maximum of 2 pages.
